The parterre fronting the saloon is longer than that at Cannons, and like it, hath a large bason of water at bottom; it is also adorned with a multitude of statues, on pedestals, as at Cannons; but the views here are prodigiously more extensive. From the terrace to the north of this parterre is the finest view I ever saw anywhere. There are also several vistas from each of the many walks that run from this parterre. This fine palace and garden lies in the middle of a spacious park, well stocked with deer, and environed with a stone wall. Palace of Hamilton.
